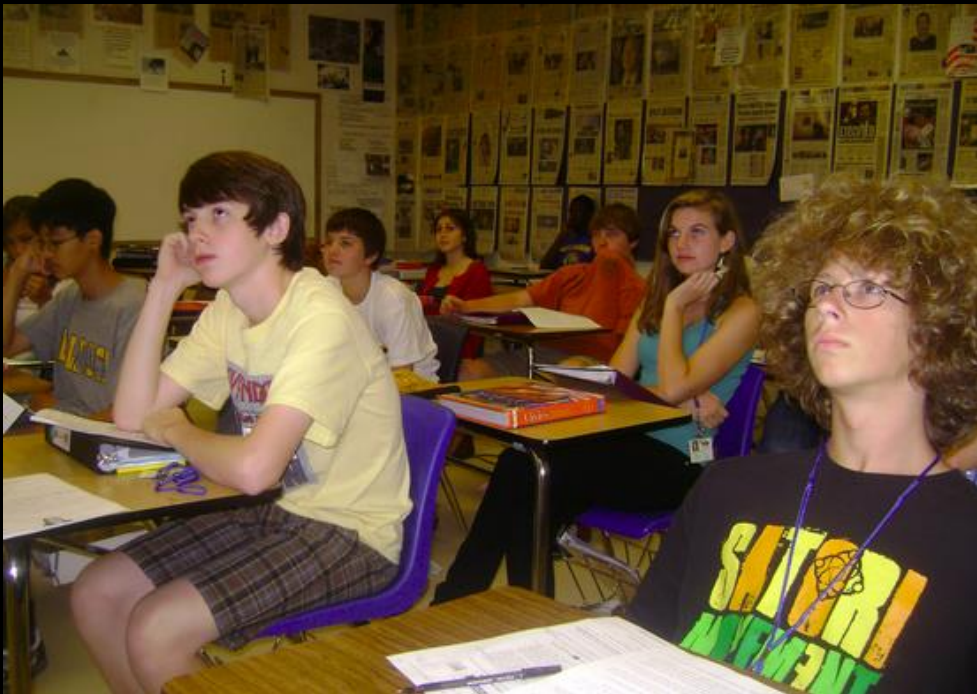

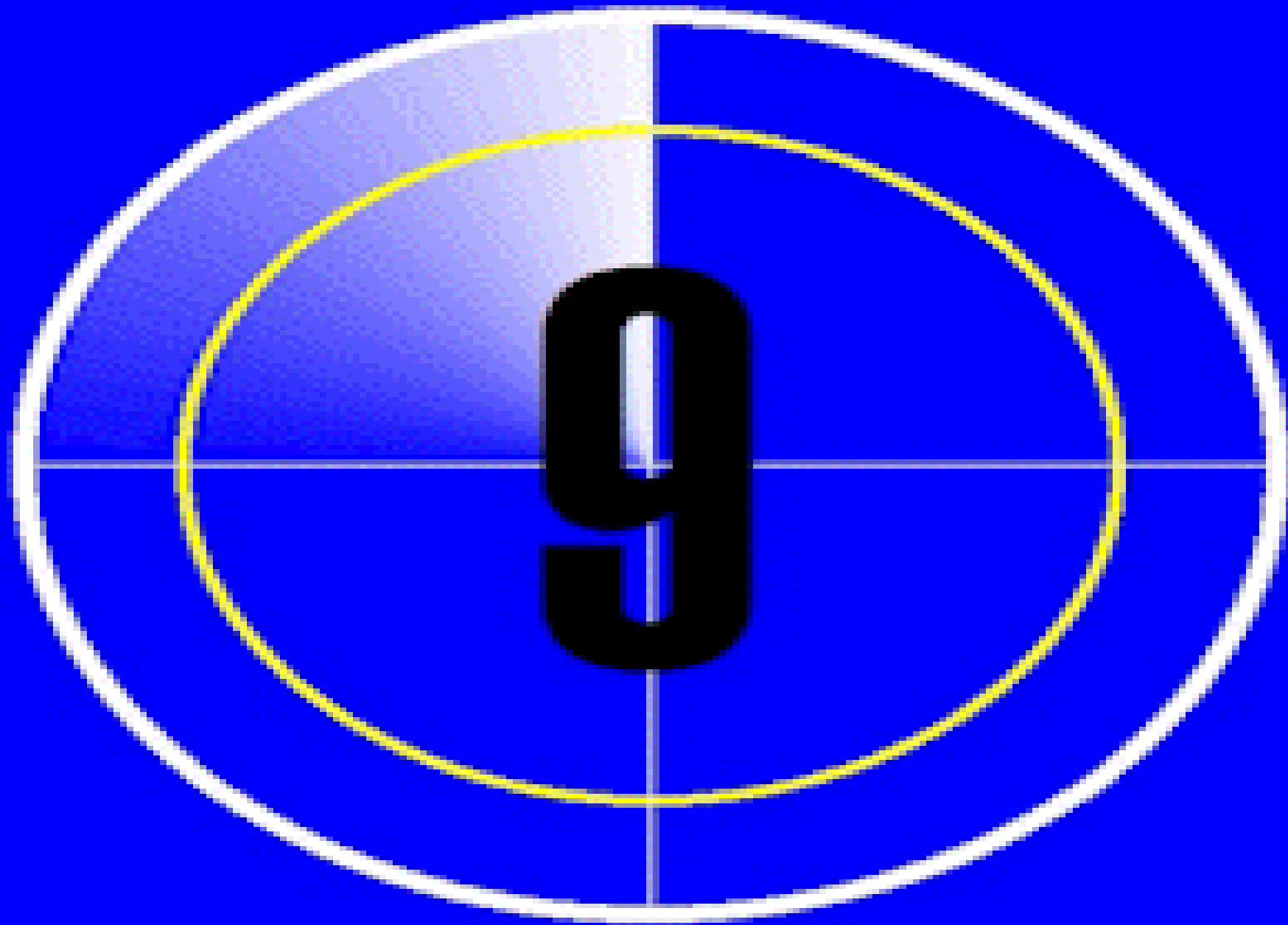


## GROUND RULES:

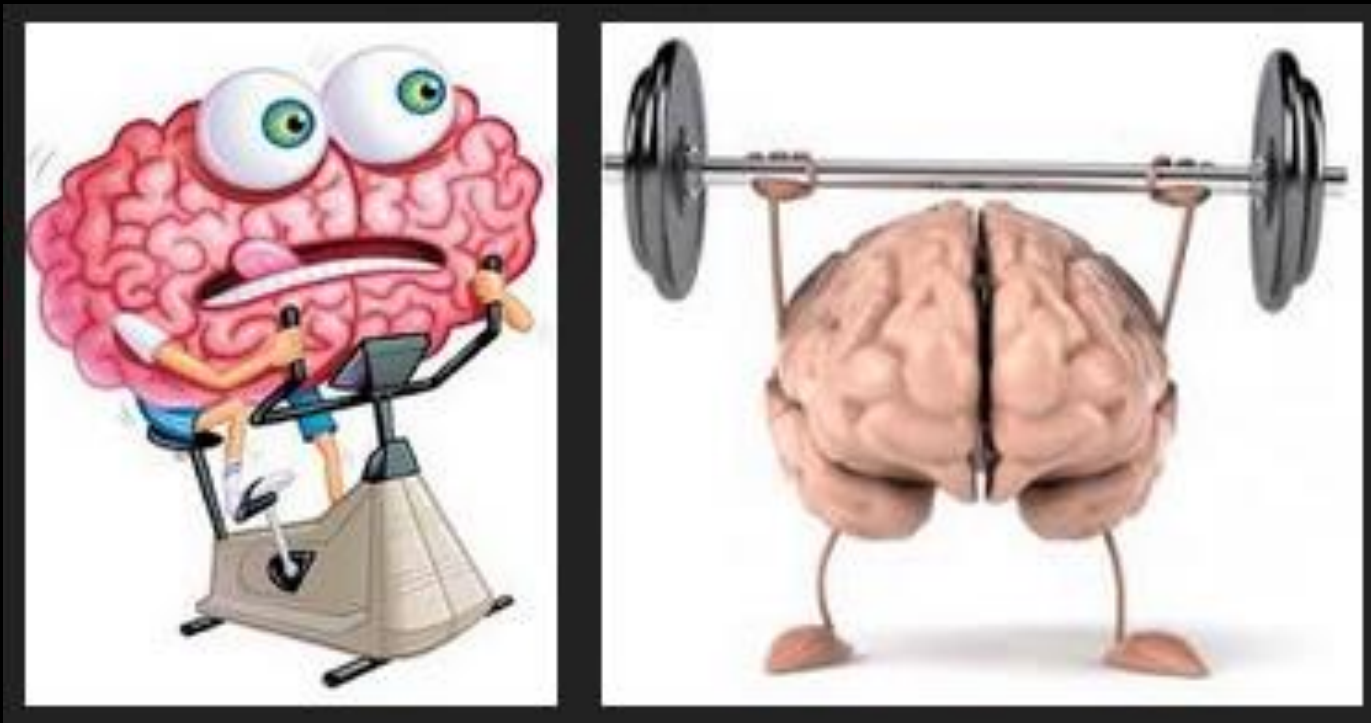




- At the beginning of class...

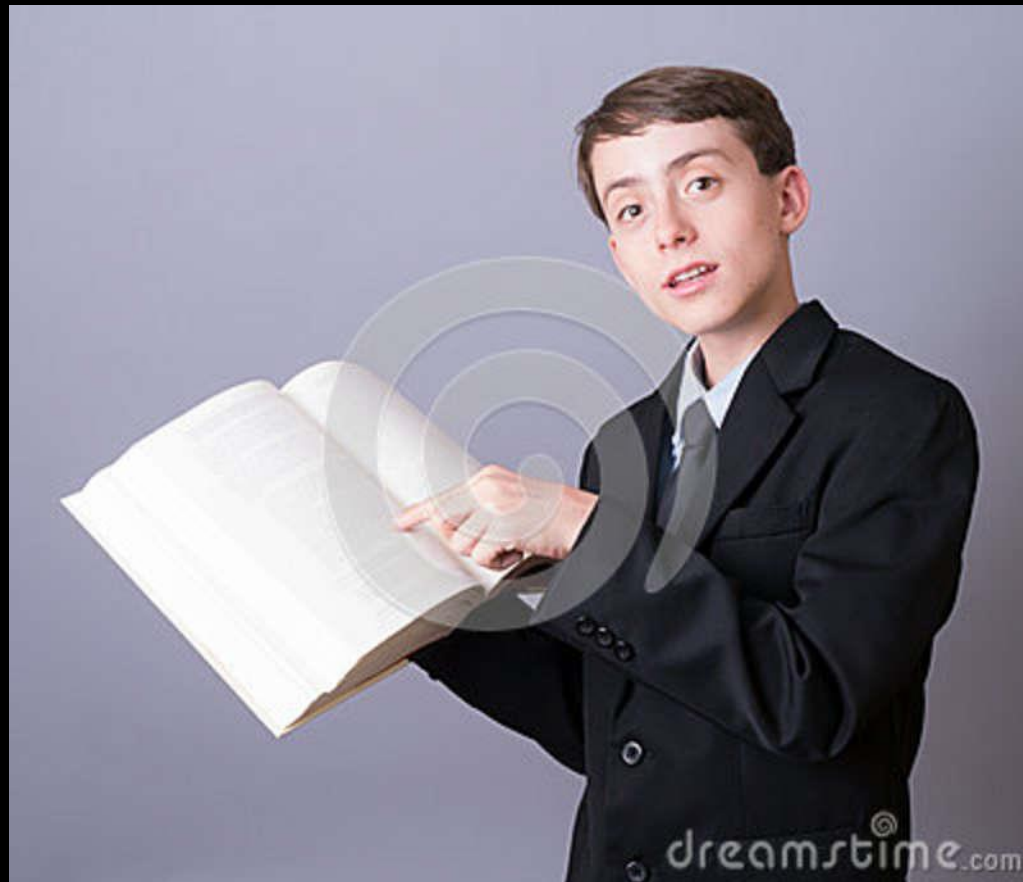

  - Teach your peer how you came up with the correct response.

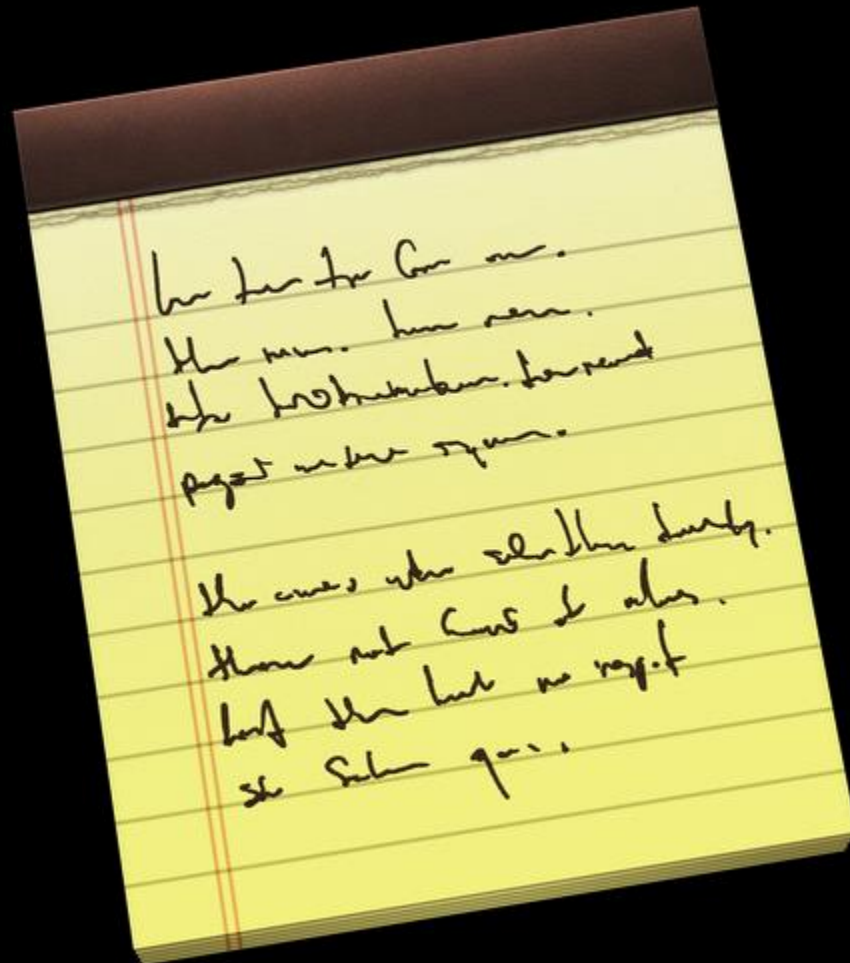
